## APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Students interested in attending Seventy-First High School's School of the Arts must complete the following:

1. Attend an audition or prepare a portfolio for assessment at Seventy-First High School at which time you will be asked to perform or submit samples of your work for evaluation.
2. Submit a one page paper describing why you would like to become a member of the School of the Arts. Paper must be typed, double spaced, in 12 pt font with 1 inch margins.
3. Submit the completed recommendation included with this application. This should be filled out by a teacher or other adult who can best describe your abilities and commitment.
4. Attach a copy of your most recent report card. Students must have and maintain an overall grade point average of 2.7 with no less than a 3.0 in your discipline area.
5. Return the School of the Arts application form, one page paper, recommendation, and copy of your most recent report card to the *Front Office* at *Seventy-First High School* by February 27, 2017.
