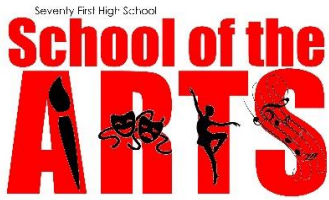
Acknowledgement of Understanding

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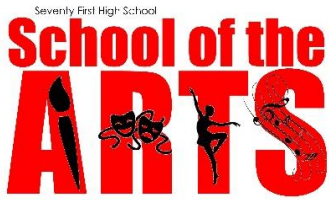
Application Procedures

Students interested in attending Seventy-First High School's School of the Arts must complete the following:

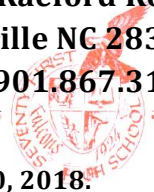
1. **Attend an audition or prepare a portfolio for assessment** at Seventy-First High School at which time you will be asked to perform or submit samples of your work for evaluation with the teacher of the student's chosen discipline.
2. **Submit a one page paper describing why you would like to become a member of the School of the Arts.** Paper must be typed, double spaced, in 12 pt font with 1 inch margins.
3. **Submit the completed recommendation** included with this application. This should be filled out by a teacher (arts teacher is preferable) or other adult who can best describe your abilities and commitment. (This is only needed for Freshman and New Students)
4. **Attach a copy of your most recent transcripts** (unofficial transcripts are acceptable). Students must have and maintain an overall grade point average of 2.7 with no less than a 3.0 in arts discipline.
5. **Return the School of the Arts application form, one page paper, recommendation, and copy of your most recent transcripts to the Front Office or Ms. Sieg at Seventy-First High School by Tuesday, February 20, 2018.**

After review of your application you will be contacted by the teacher(s) of your chosen discipline area to schedule a date and time for your audition/interview.
